

Two-day Workshop

Narrative Practice with Children and Young People

(7 December – 8 December 2011)

About the Facilitator:

Jane Hutton qualified as a social worker in 1985 and has pursued an interest in narrative ways of working since her introduction to them in 1986. She combines a part time private practice in a small country town with teaching, supervision and running a Bed and Breakfast.

After spending a few years in the area of rehabilitation Jane worked for 8 years with young people and their families doing individual, family and group counseling within an Adolescent Health Service. She has published on narrative group work with young women who have experienced sexual assault. For the past 18 years Jane has been in private practice, with a particular interest in working in the area of mental health and with children and young people. She has a passion for teaching narrative therapy, and has taught within Australia and internationally, for the Dulwich Centre, privately, and in a number of University contexts.

Workshop Description

This two day workshop will explore narrative ways of working with children and young people. It will incorporate the use of creative and playful ways of engaging with younger children, including drawing and story telling and capturing. Ways of approaching common problems such as worry, fear and temper using the narrative practice maps will be represented in case examples. Whole school approach to school bullying situations will be considered. Working with adolescents and young adults will be considered in relation to family conflict, suicidality, anorexia/bulimia and drug abuse. Participants will have the opportunity to consider, observe and practice the ideas of distress as a tribute, personal failure and the absent but implicit in relation to this work. The workshop will offer theoretical input, case examples, video, and exercises that link participants practice to the ideas presented.
