

## **Professor/Associate Professor/Assistant Professor (PR080/09-10)**

The Department of Economics of Hong Kong Baptist University invites applications for the above positions commencing September 2010. Applicants in all economic fields will be considered, but preferences will be given to those with expertise in one or more of the following areas:

- *Macroeconomics*
- *International Economics*
- *Applied Econometrics*

Applicants should have a relevant PhD degree with proven research record. Those with specific knowledge of area studies, such as China or Asia, will have added advantage. Applicants for these positions should be able to demonstrate commitment to excellence in research and teaching and to be willing to work collaboratively with colleagues. Evidence of the ability to publish in top-tier journals is required. The appointee is expected to teach courses and supervise student projects at the undergraduate and postgraduate levels. Appointments will normally be made initially on a contract basis for up to three years, renewable and substantiable subject to review and mutual agreement. Remuneration and rank will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.
